

Coaching and OJT



Background

This online course is delivered through <u>Spark!</u> By OES-NA. The course is intended to provide system personnel with an explanation and understanding of the On-the-Job Training process and aspects related to coaching new operators in learning the responsibility of a real-time operating position. The course steps through the various topics associated with coaching, OJT, and evaluation during the process. Each lesson is culminated with a review and quiz. Upon completion of the lessons, there is a final assessment that consists of 10 multiple choice questions. Individuals must attain a passing grade of 70% on the final assessment in order to be awarded the NERC CEHs.
